About the Oxford Program

Georgia Tech's Oxford Program takes place every summer and is composed of two sections: **Travel & In-Residence**. The program begins with 5 weeks of travel, as students journey by bus through multiple European cities in travel groups consisting of 55 students, 2 professors, a European Tour Guide, and a **GT Group Leader**. Students take two courses during this portion of the program, attending lectures and visiting historic and cultural sites that directly support their coursework. After 1 week studying in Atlanta and 5 weeks of experiential learning across Europe, students complete their ID & MUSC courses and depart for **Oxford, England** where they spend the next 6 weeks In-Residence and complete two more courses. Once students arrive in Oxford, the duties and responsibilities of the Group Leader for the travel portion conclude.

A Typical Day on the Road

7:00 AM – Catch up with the group at breakfast
8:00 AM – Lead students to 1st excursion
10:30 AM – City walking tour
12:00 PM – Grab a quick lunch
1:30 PM – Meet students at museum #2
3:00 PM – Free time
3:15 PM – Not so fast... a student needs a doctor's visit
7:00 PM – Meet students at concert
10:00 PM – Finally, you're done!
10:30 PM – Start mentally preparing for tomorrow :)

Application Process

1. Submit completed application form and additional materials on the <https://oxford.gatech.edu/content/group-leader-application> before January 5, 2026
 - NOTE: Group Leader applications will not be reviewed without written confirmation to be released from home department.
2. Panel interviews for finalists will be conducted by OIE staff members.
3. All final decisions will be made by the Program Director.

Group Leader Responsibilities

- Assist the on-site logistical expert (European Tour Guide) for the travel portion of the program:
 - Help check the group into hotels, museums, restaurants, etc.
 - Assist in coordinating transportation to excursions and cities
 - Assist professors with classroom set up and breakdown.
- Serve as the on-site liaison between the Office of International Education & the Dean of Students.
- Monitor and help with issues regarding student health, discipline, safety, and well-being.
- Assist faculty members.
- Accompany students on international flights to first destination city.
- Maintain professional conduct and uphold Georgia Tech policies & procedures at all times.

Group Leader Details

- Group Leaders must be U.S. citizens employed as **full-time faculty or staff at GT** with exempt salary status.
- Employee classification must be **exempt & non-hourly**.
- The following expenses are covered for travel Group Leaders:
 - Round-trip airfare
 - Housing
 - Transportation between cities
 - Entrance to all class excursions
 - Reimbursed for Institute-approved per diem
- **Group Leaders do not receive a salary from the Oxford Program** and must have approval from their home department to be paid while away from the office for program travel.

Visitors outside the program are **highly discouraged**. Spouses, partners, family members, friends, and any other non-participants **MUST** have prior approval from the Program Director to visit at any point during the program. The group living arrangements and program schedule do not accommodate dependent children.

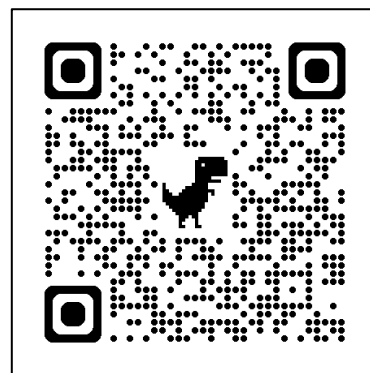
